

Access Control Management (Deploy Security Equipment)

Course Objectives:

This course specifies the Abilities (A) and Knowledge (K) required by the security supervisor to interpret the security plan, deploy the equipment and supervise the security personnel for access control, alarm monitoring and CCTV monitoring.

Course Content: The course contains the following Abilities (A):

- A1- Deploy and activate access equipment in accordance with organisation procedures
- A2- Conduct briefing and site orientations of the access control equipment to security personnel
- A3- Verify and respond to security personnel's reports on unauthorised entries
- A4- Carry out routine checks on security personnel & equipment to ensure manning & serviceability levels for critical equipment
- A5- Report equipment faults or repair requirements to maintenance contractor and ensure remedial actions are taken
- A6- Prepare and maintain records and documentation
- A7- Recommend adjustments in deployment of access control equipment

Learners are expected to be 18 years old and above.
